



Clay's Corner

What's in a name? Have you ever wondered what your name means? I did a little research on mine and found that my first name, Ralph, comes from a Nordic word that means, "wolf counsel". Methuselah His death shall bring The Despairing Noah Rest, or comfort

That is an interesting list of meaningful names. But read the meanings again, this time strung together in sentence form. "Man (is) appointed mortal sorrow; (but) the Blessed God shall come down teaching (that) His death shall bring (the) despairing rest."

I don't know about you but I find it very interesting that the Gospel message of the Christ is first found in the names of the Patriarchs of Genesis. And that the events of that period of time are a reflection of the prophecies not only of the present but also of the future when Christ would come and walk among men to bring rest and comfort to a sin sick world.
