## Your defense should start from the beginning

Sometimes no matter how well we know things, when asked why? We can't answer. There is a challenge to verbalize things you feel strongly about. It seems it should be easy. When we love something so much it should be easy to tell or convince people as to why they are our favorite things. You can ask a child why is that torn and worn blanket so special? Why is a raggedy doll still your favorite toy? The responses can range from a simple because, or I don't know. These are my children's responses any way. You know there is a strong meaning behind the beloved doll or blanket, but it may not be verbalized.

The Apostle Peter challenges us by saying, "but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence" (1 Peter 3:15). Peter gives us three challenges that make up one; be ready, have a good attitude, and give an answer. These can all be hard but that last one is the foundation for the other two. We must be prepared to defend our hope in Christ from those who don't know or would oppose God's truth. "The defense and confirmation of the gospel" (Philippians 1:7). How can we do this? Where do we even start?

Throughout the entire Old Testament God has been hinting at something big; something complete, something perfect that will solve the world's problems! The problem we see from very early on in existence is sin. God has said He has a plan that will ultimately put mankind back into the intended relationship with Him. Coming to the New Testament we now see that Jesus is that plan. He is the ultimate problem solver. He is the reason for the hope in every Christian.

That needs to be the start of our defense. God made a promise to bring mankind back into a relationship with Him. Throughout time he has doubled down on that promise. God has made a step in the ultimate sacrifice by manifesting Himself in the form of a human. Being the begotten son Jesus, the Messiah. This isn't the end of our defense, but it is the beginning. Intersecting point from promise to the eventual Death, Burial, and Resurrection. My challenge for you starting this week is to form your reasoning or defense for what and why you believe what you believe. It needs to convey the importance and urgency of the message but as well as the love and grace. Despite what are gifts are we need to be able to verbalize why we radically give our lives to a Man who radically changes the world.
